### **CCES begins process to update Canadian Anti-Doping Program: Results for April to June 2008 Testing Program**

(Ottawa, Ontario – August 7, 2008) – The Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) reported strong results for the first quarter of the fiscal year, with testing numbers up, violations down, and a national consultation underway on a revision to Canadian doping control rules.

From April to June 2008, the CCES conducted a total of 1,159 doping control tests. Of these, 874 tests were under the domestic doping control program, a Sport Canada-funded initiative which serves Canadian athletes in all recognized sports. Many of these tests were targeted at athletes heading to the 2008 Beijing Olympic and Paralympic Games under a pre-games testing policy. Only one anti-doping rule violation was reported during the quarter: a cycling athlete received a warning and reprimand for a cannabis violation.

The remaining 285 tests were conducted on a fee-for-service basis. Thirty-nine tests were carried out for the Association of National Anti-Doping Organizations (ANADO) which contracts doping control internationally. A highlight of this quarter was the doping control mission (80 tests) conducted at the IIHF Hockey Championships held in Halifax and Quebec City, as part of the CCES's mandate to perform doping control on behalf of national and international federations during events held in Canada.

The CCES also began a major update of the Canadian anti-doping rules on behalf of the Canadian sport community. Stakeholders had the opportunity to comment on the first draft during a series of national consultations in June. The revised Canadian Anti-Doping Program, re-aligned with the newest World Anti-Doping Code, will be released in October and will come into effect on January 1, 2009 in tandem with the new World Code.

The CCES's online education program was extended this quarter when Football Canada and its two leagues, the Canadian Junior Football League (CJFL) and the Quebec Junior Football

League (QJFL), made a standard e-learning course mandatory for all of their players. Members of the Football Canada Cup Under 17 and Under 19 teams are also required to complete the online course prior to competing. The CJFL went a step further, and made the course mandatory for its coaches as well.
